Mr. Kelly introduced Mr. Sokol, representing the project.

Mr. Sokol explained that he would entertain any questions that might come up regarding this project. All public mailers were mailed out.

Mr. Pellegrini asked for clarification of the reasoning behind the proposed revocation. He confirmed that it was requested by the bank, Mr. Sokol confirmed.

Mr. Kelly asked for the road easements to be explained. Mr. Sokol explained that the township has 21 years to open the road, if they do not they lose their right to open the road, but the roadway still maintains an easement that the entire subdivision still has rights to use.

Mr. Pellegrini asked for confirmation that they were not building over top of those right of ways, in which Mr. Sokol confirmed. The area is staked out already.

Mr. Goroncy asked if the plan will show all the parcels being combined. Mr. Sokol explained that they would likely be hooked together, because of the system updates that are needed.

Mr. Pellegrini made a motion for a Final Approval, seconded by Ms. Knapik. All were in favor and Final Approval was granted.

Mr. Kelly explained that the Federal Highway Administration is trying to remove Rt. 21 from the FHA list of roads. This would be detrimental to our area and several meetings occurred to help curtail that decision. Results are pending.
