Minutes

A business meeting of the Center Township Board of Supervisors was held on Thursday, April 14, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. at the Township Office in Rogersville. Present were Paul Cook, Vice Chairman, Seann McCollum, Supervisor, Chris Furman, Solicitor and N. Dawn Horr, Secretary. Minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed and Paul made a motion to approve them as read. Seconded by Seann and motion was carried.

Caitlin Carlisle asked for an update on the walking bridge in Rogersville. Paul explained that with the state budget passed, a meeting should be held soon for the pending grant application.


Sean made a motion to adopt Ordinance No. 1-2016 for residential new construction tax abatements. Paul seconded and motion carried. Seann then made a motion to adopt Ordinance No. 2-2016 for tax abatements for residential improvements. Paul seconded and motion was carried.

The township is in receipt of applications for a junkyard and junk dealer license for the Amos junkyard on Bluff Ridge Road. Seann made a motion that a vote be held to approve or deny the license applications. The motion died for lack of a second. Paul made a motion to table the decision until the next meeting. The motion died for lack of a second. Solicitor Furman suggested that the supervisors authorize the code enforcement officer to proceed with measures to bring the junkyard into compliance.

There will be an electronics-recycling program held quarterly by the county at the fairgrounds. The first collection will be April 20th from 2:00 to 5:00 p.m.

Paul made a motion to approve the bills as presented. Seann seconded and motion was carried.
