Minutes

A business meeting of the Center Township Board of Supervisors was held on Thursday, February 11, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. at the Township Office in Rogersville. Present were Edward A. (Butch) Deter, Chairman, Paul Cook, Vice Chairman, Seann McCollum, Supervisor, Chris Furman, Solicitor and N. Dawn Horr, Secretary. Visitors were Larry Mitchell, Kurt Katchmark, Michele King, Harry Gillispie, Gene Rush, Steven Ashcraft, Glenn Eddy, Vince Sappington, Dave Brendel and Brian Hughes.

Minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed and Seann made a motion to approve them as read. Seconded by Paul and motion was carried unanimously.

Harry Gillispie asked the supervisors what their role is with the old school property in Rogersville. It was explained that the township is assisting the Greene Co. Redevelopment Authority with the clean up of the property with proposed plans for new housing development.

Glenn Eddy asked that the potholes on Hopewell Ridge and Barton Hollow be filled and that Pine Road near Scott Run be plowed. Vince Sappington stated that Cole Hollow was damaged by the township when plowing.

Three bids for stone received from Greer Limestone Co, Hanson Aggregates and Laurel Aggregates were opened and read. The tabulations follow the minutes. Seann made a motion to award the contract to Laurel Aggregates as the lowest bidder. Paul seconded and motion was carried unanimously.

One bid was received for the diesel fuel from Coen Oil Co. Paul made a motion to award the contract to them. Seann seconded and the motion was carried unanimously.

Seann made a motion to approve the McNay to Vista Gathering lot split. Paul seconded and the motion was carried unanimously.

Paul made a motion to approve the Orndoff to Moore lot split. Seconded by Seann and the motion was carried unanimously.

Seann made a motion to approve the bills as presented. Paul seconded and motion was carried unanimously.

A motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Paul. Seann seconded and the meeting was adjourned at 7:25 p.m.
