

Center Township
Board of Supervisors
July 14, 2016
Minutes

A business meeting of the Center Township Board of Supervisors was held on Thursday, July 14, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. at the Township Office in Rogersville. Present were Edward A. Deter, Chairman, Paul Cook, Vice Chairman, Seann McCollum, Supervisor, Chris Furman, Solicitor and N. Dawn Horr, Secretary. Visitors were David Joseph, Larry Mitchell, Steve Ashcraft, Glenn Eddy, Michele King, Kurt Katchmark and Casey Durdines.

Minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed and Seann made a motion to approve them as read. Seconded by Paul and motion was carried.

Glenn Eddy offered to help with the roadside mowing on a part time basis as he feels it should be done quicker. Butch stated that he has been mowing for the past three weeks and explained how he starts in a different location each year.

The representatives from the conservation district stated that there are a lot of mosquitoes being caught in the traps at the sewer plant but none have tested positive for the west Nile virus. They do expect a positive result as there was one last year and the mosquitoes are so plentiful.

The bids for approximately 80,000 gallons of E3 emulsified asphalt and approximately 50,000 gallons of MC 70 were opened and read. Upon reading the bid documents Seann stated that the supervisors wanted E3 "modified"; the word modified was erroneously not on the bid sheets. Therefore Seann made a motion to reject the bids for the E3 emulsified asphalt and to re-advertise for bids for E3 modified asphalt. Butch seconded and Paul opposed.

Three bids were received for the MC70 emulsified asphalt as follows:

Suit-Kote Corp.	\$1.834	\$91,700
Russell Standard Corp.	\$2.136	\$106,800
Midland Asphalt	\$2.257	\$112,850

Paul made a motion to award the bid contract for the MC70 to Suite-Kote as the lowest bidder. Seann seconded and the motion was carried unanimously.

Seann made a motion to re-advertise for bids for approx. 80,000 gallons of E3 Modified emulsified asphalt. The bids will be opened and read at a special meeting. Paul seconded and motion was carried unanimously.

As the supervisors recently learned that the grant to replace the footbridge at the park was not awarded to the Township, Paul made a motion to move forward using the Act 13 funds to pay for the replacement. Butch seconded and Seann abstained. Seann explained that he has at least one company already committed to help fund the costs and that Paul's motion did not have a ceiling for funding used towards the project. He is however in favor of moving forward with the project and suggests more effort be made in obtaining funding from other grants and companies. A meeting has already been set with our engineer to get started.

Butch made a motion to approve the bills as presented. Paul seconded and motion was carried.

A motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Seann. Paul seconded and the meeting was adjourned at 7:30 p.m.
