May 12, 2016
Minutes

A business meeting of the Center Township Board of Supervisors was held on Thursday, May 12, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. at the Township Office in Rogersville. Present were Edward A. Deter, Chairman, Paul Cook, Vice Chairman, Seann McCollum, Supervisor, Chris Furman, Solicitor and N. Dawn Horr, Secretary. Visitors were Larry Mitchell, Kurt Katchmark, Harry Gillispie, and Dave Brendel.

Minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed and Paul made a motion to approve them as read. Seconded by Seann and motion was carried.

Kurt Katchmark stated that the stop sign at the end of Cole Hollow Road needs replaced. Also, the road sign at the intersection needs to be reset.

The applications for a junkyard and junk dealer license for the Amos junkyard on Bluff Ridge Road were discussed. Seann made a motion to deny the applications at this time, as they are not in compliance. Butch seconded. Paul opposed. Solicitor Furman stated that they would have 90 days to bring the junkyard into compliance. If it is not cleaned up, a notice will be sent that they are in violation and they will have another 30 days from the date of notice. If they comply, they may reapply for the licenses.

The meeting for the walking bridge grant application will be held on Monday, June 13 at 12:30 in Harrisburg. The bridge was inspected by MR Structures and again found to be structurally deficient. He will let the supervisors know if he has any suggestions on how the bridge may be repaired.

An informational meeting will be held at the Rogersville fire hall for the proposed construction of the Foundation Mine in Holbrook on Weds., May 25th from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.

The March for Greene will be held on Sat., May 14th at 10:00 a.m. in Waynesburg. The march and rally are being held to bring awareness to substance abuse in our area.

The Board of Supervisors recently met with the West Greene School Board to discuss the continued use of the ball fields at the park for school activities. The agreement to use the ball fields will expire this year.

Seann made a motion to approve the bills as presented. Paul seconded and motion was carried.

A motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Paul. Seann seconded and the meeting was adjourned at 7:20 p.m.
