

Center Township
Board of Supervisors
September 8, 2016
Minutes

A business meeting of the Center Township Board of Supervisors was held on Thursday, September 8, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. at the Township Office in Rogersville. Present were Edward A. Deter, Chairman, Paul Cook, Vice Chairman, Seann McCollum, Supervisor, Chris Furman, Solicitor and N. Dawn Horr, Secretary. Visitors were Larry Mitchell, Brian Hughes, Harry Gillispie, David Brendel, Kurt Katchmark, Gene and Judy Rush, Michele King, Vince Sappington and Jennifer Rizer.

Minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed and Seann made a motion to approve them as read. Seconded by Paul and motion was carried.

Dave Brendel thanked the Supervisors for the repairs that were made to Pine Road. Seann stated that the EQT subcontractor performed the work at the supervisors' request.

Mr. Sappington had several questions and comments about road maintenance on Cole Hollow and Center Highlands Roads.

Mr. Gillispie asked if any road bank mowing had been performed since the last meeting. It was explained that once oiling & chipping is complete the mowing would resume.

Jennifer Rizer stated that a truck had turned in her new concrete driveway leaving tar and now there is a crack in the concrete. She asked that the supervisors contact them to resolve the issue. The supervisors stated that they would visit the site in the near future. Mrs. Rizer also thanked the supervisors for the work that was performed on her road, Center Highlands.

Butch stated that there have been no positive West Nile test results on the conservation district's mosquito traps at the sewer plant.

Fall Clean Up Day will be held on Saturday, October 8th from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Electronics and tires will be accepted. The fee for tires has been raised to \$3.00.

The Greene Co. Commissioners and Rep. Pam Snyder will sponsor an electronics collection day on Weds. Sept. 14th from 2:00 to 5:00 p.m. at the Greene Co. Fairgrounds.

The Bristol lot split was reviewed. Seann made a motion to approve the lot split contingent upon Rodney Bristor combining the 30.001 acres with the 2.302 acres he currently owns, forming one deed so the 2.302 acres will not be land-locked. Paul seconded and the motion was carried unanimously.

Oiling and chipping of various township roadways will take place the week on September 12th and will be done by the 16th, weather permitting.


