

## NEWS RELEASE

The Greene County Court of Common Pleas has released its plan for establishing boundaries of the Magisterial Districts in the County.

Pennsylvania law requires that all counties in the Commonwealth, including Greene, review the workload and boundaries of the Magisterial Districts within the county. The general purpose of this requirement is to make sure that each district has approximately the same workload, and to make modifications and adjustments to the district boundaries if necessary.

The Thirteenth Judicial District, Greene County, has completed its review and hereby offers it for public inspection and comment. The plan calls for the retention of all three existing magisterial districts. It also calls for the shifting of the townships of Perry, Whiteley, and Washington from Magisterial District 13-3-02 to Magisterial District 13-3-01.
