Greene County Sheriff's Office Arrests Wanted Man

January 5, 2017

Acting on an anonymous tip, the Greene County Sheriff's Office apprehended Briar Jones Wednesday, January 4, 2017 on a warrant issued out of Marshall County, West Virginia. The warrant was issued in November of 2016 and multiple agencies had been searching for him since its issuance. Jones was taken into custody late Wednesday afternoon on a well pad access road in the Windy Gap area of Aleppo Township, Greene County, PA, without incident. This was made possible through multiple anonymous tips, interagency cooperation, and a multijurisdictional team of Greene County Sheriff's Deputies and other agencies. Additional charges are pending for Jones, as he was found to be in possession of a suspected controlled substance. "I would like to thank Marshall County, WV Sheriff's Deputies, the US Marshals Service, and those who helped with giving us the anonymous tips that aided us in the apprehension. Additionally, I could not be more proud of my Deputies and the work they are doing to help keep Greene County safe." Greene County Sheriff Brian Tennant said of the incident. Jones is currently being held in the Greene County Prison.
