GREENE COUNTY SHERIFFS OFFICE ARREST WANTED WOMAN, FIND DRUGS

Following up on an anonymous tip, Deputies from the Greene County Sheriff's Office were headed to a residence to search for Tammy L Yakubec. A warrant had been issued for Yakubec after she failed to appear in court for Possession of a controlled substance charges. In addition to where she had been staying, it was reported that she was driving a white truck. While driving to the area deputies encountered a white truck driving on Piper Ridge Road in Waynesburg, the driver was recognized by Deputies to be Tammy L Yakubec, who does not have a drivers license. The deputies initiated a traffic stop and arrested Yakubec. During the arrest process, deputies found multiple syringes, multiple pieces of suspected drug paraphernalia, a suspected crack pipe, and 45 stamp bags of suspected Heroin. Yakubec is being held in the Greene County Jail. Additional Charges are pending. "The Greene County Sheriff's Office is committed to holding people accountable for their crimes. Warrant service is a priority for us, as such, I have reassigned two Deputies, whose primary focus is warrant service. Since February 1, 2017 these 2 Deputies have been responsible for 16 people being arrested and brought before the courts for their various charges, I am incredibly proud and thankful for the job they are doing."
