


Scott Covered Bridge



Bridge Number:

Crosses over the south fork of Ten-Mile Creek ,
west / NW of Rogersville in Center Township,
Greene County, PA



Built in 1885, and covered with unpainted vertical board on both the sides and portals of the bridge, the Scott Bridge had a roof of sheet metal and a deck of crosswise planking. One side window is cut into the center of the queen-post truss structure in addition to the typical lengthwise openings under the eaves of the bridge.



A simple, one-span, non-composite, Steel I-Beam structure, and rests on cut stone abutments. The Scott Covered Bridge remains open to vehicular traffic today.
