GREENE COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPUTIES ARREST MAN ON DRUG WARRANT/ ADDITIONAL DRUG CHARGES PENDING

In the early evening hours on April 6, 2017 Deputies from the Greene County Sheriff's Office were traveling to attempt to serve a warrant on Amnie Lawver, 55 of Uniontown. Lawver was wanted for failing to appear on Felony charges of Manufacture, Delivery, or Possession with Intent to Manufacture or Deliver a Controlled Substance. An anonymous tip had come in that he was staying at a house in Alisha and was driving a blue Subaru. While in route to the residence deputies passed a blue Subaru, and recognized the driver as Lawver on SR88 in Monongahela township. Deputies initiated a traffic stop, Lawver slowed down and began to throw bags from his vehicle. Lawver was eventually stopped and taken in to custody without incident. Drug paraphernalia and \$452 cash was found during his arrest. The discarded bags were recovered and contained suspected cocaine and crack. Lawver is being housed in the Greene County Jail, additional charges are pending. Cumberland Township and Masontown Police responded to assist with the incident. "Our deputies are doing an incredible job taking wanted people and drugs off the streets of Greene County.
